Summary of data

The figures that follow show the number of postgraduate students at Monash from different perspectives; campus, faculty, sex, age, domestic or international, Indigenous, commencing or returning, attendance mode, attendance type, funding source and course type.

University-wide numbers

In both 2006 and 2007, 29% of students at Monash University were enrolled in a postgraduate degree. This figure declined to 28.21% in 2008.

Between 2006 and 2007, postgraduate numbers increased by 1.16% overall.

Between 2007 and 2008 postgraduate numbers decreased by 0.48% overall.

Campus

In 2006, 82% of postgraduates were situated on the Clayton and Caulfield campuses.

In 2007 and 2008, 84% of postgraduates were situated on the Clayton and Caulfield campuses.

Postgraduate numbers more than doubled on the Sunway campus each year.

From 2006 to 2008 Caulfield, Clayton, and Parkville postgraduate numbers increased by 3%, 2% and 33% respectively while postgraduate numbers on the Peninsula, Gippsland and Berwick campuses decreased.

From 2007 to 2008 postgraduate numbers increased by 2.4% at Parkville, but decreased at the following campuses: Caulfield (-1%); Clayton (-0.8%); Berwick (-4.8%); Gippsland (-6.9%).

Faculty

In each year from 2006 to 2008, 68% of postgraduates were enrolled in either the Faculty of Business and Economics (30%), Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences (20%) or Education (18%).

From 2006-2007:

- the Faculty of Information Technology had the largest decrease in postgraduate student numbers, with a 14.6% decline
- the Faculty of Pharmacy & Pharmaceutical Sciences had the largest increase in postgraduate student numbers, with a 30% increase

From 2007 – 2008:

- the Faculty of Information Technology had the largest decrease in postgraduate student numbers, with an 11.34% decline
- the Faculty of Art and Design had the largest increase in postgraduate student numbers with a 17.8% increase

Course type

In 2006, 21% of the postgraduate population were enrolled in a higher degree by research (HDR) and 79% in a graduate/postgraduate coursework (GPG) degree.

- In 2007, HDR enrolments comprised 22% and GPG 78% of the postgraduate population.
- In 2008, HDR enrolments comprised 23% and GPG 77% of the postgraduate population.
- Between 2006 and 2007, HDR numbers increased by 2.6% and GPG numbers increased by 0.7%.
- Between 2007 and 2008, HDR numbers increased by 4.2% and GPG numbers increased by 1.8%.

Course level

Each year, the majority of the postgraduates enrolled in HDR, were enrolled in a PhD: 76% in both 2006 and 2007; 78% in 2008. The majority of the postgraduates enrolled in GPG were enrolled in a Masters by Coursework: 68% in 2006; 70% in 2007; 73% in 2008.

- Between 2006 and 2007, PhD enrolments increased by 3.6% and Masters by Coursework enrolments increased by 3%.
- Between 2007 and 2008, PhD enrolments increased by 6% and Masters by Coursework enrolments increased by 3%.

Commencing and returning

- Between 2006 and 2007, the number of commencing HDR postgraduates decreased by 1.6%, while the number of returning HDR postgraduates increased by 4.6%.
- Between 2007 and 2008, the number of commencing HDR postgraduates increased by 2.3%, while the number of returning HDR postgraduates increased by 4.9%.
- Between 2006 and 2007 the number of commencing GPG postgraduates increased by 4.3%, while the number of returning GPG postgraduates decreased by 2.7%.
- Between 2007 and 2008 the number of commencing GPG postgraduates decreased by 6.8%, while the number of returning GPG postgraduates increased by 3.2%.

Age

Each year from 2006 to 2008: the average age of a postgraduate was 32, the HDR average age was 35; and the GPG average age was 31.

Domestic and international

In 2006, 30% of postgraduates were international students. This figure increased to 31.5% in 2007 and 33% in 2008.

International postgraduates were mainly situated on the Clayton, Caulfield and Gippsland campuses:

In 2006:

- 43% of postgraduates on the Caulfield campus were international
- 26% of postgraduates on the Gippsland campus were international
- 23% of postgraduates on the Clayton campus were international

In 2007:

- 46% of postgraduates on the Caulfield campus were international
- 24% of postgraduates on the Gippsland campus were international
- 25% of postgraduates on the Clayton campus were international

In 2008:

- 47% of postgraduates on the Caulfield campus were international
- 20% of postgraduates on the Gippsland campus were international
- 26% of postgraduates on the Clayton campus were international

Between 2006 and 2007:

- international postgraduate numbers increased on Clayton and Caulfield campuses in both HDR and GPG enrolments
- at Caulfield, international HDR numbers increased by 29%, although actual numbers were small

- international HDR numbers increased overall by 17.6%
- there was an increase of international HDR numbers in each faculty with the largest percentage increase in Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences (47.4%) and Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences (40.3%)
- international GPG numbers increased overall by 4%
- the largest increase of 22.8% was in the Education Faculty. International GPG numbers decreased in the faculties of Information Technology; Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences and Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences

Between 2007 and 2008:

- international HDR postgraduate numbers increased by 16% at Caulfield and 18% at Clayton. International HDR postgraduate numbers increased at Gippsland, Parkville and Peninsula, although actual numbers were small
- international HDR numbers increased overall by 21%
- law numbers did not change
- international HDR numbers increased in all other faculties. The largest percentage increases were: ArtDes (50% - although actual numbers were small); Edu (47.5%); MNHS (35%); and Arts (33%)
- international GPG numbers increased overall by 1.3%
- the largest percentage increases were: ArtDes (24%, but actual numbers were small); and Arts (23%)
- international GPG numbers decreased in Eng, IT, Law, MNHS, Pharmacy and Science

Funding source

Between 2006 and 2007, the number of:

- RTS places allocated to HDRs increased by 6.7%
- international fee paying HDRs increased by 17.7%
- international fee paying GPG students increased by 4.3%
- domestic fee paying GPG students, both FEE-HELP and non FEE-HELP decreased by 2.3%
- CSP increased by 1.1%

Between 2007 and 2008, the number of:

- RTS places allocated to HDRs increased by 6.3%
- overseas fee-paying HDRs increased by 42.6%
- overseas fee-paying GPG students increased by 5.4%
- domestic fee-paying GPG students, both FEE-HELP and non FEE-HELP decreased by 8.95%
- commonwealth supported increased by 4.4%

Sex

In 2006, 2007 and 2008 there were more female HDR and GPG students than males.

- Between 2006 and 2007 HDR female numbers increased by 5.6% while HDR male numbers decreased by 0.2%.
- Between 2007 and 2008 HDR female numbers increased by 6.4%, while HDR male numbers increased by 1.5%.
- Between 2006 and 2007 GPG female numbers increased by 2.8% while GPG male numbers decreased by 2.4%

- Between 2007 and 2008, GPG female numbers increased by 0.18% while GPG male numbers decreased by 4.7%

Attendance type

In 2006, 2007 and 2008 more postgraduates were enrolled part-time than full-time.

Between 2006 and 2007:

- full-time HDR and GPG enrolments increased by 6.5% and 8.1% respectively
- part-time HDR and GPG enrolments decreased by 2.5% and 4.4% respectively

Between 2007 and 2008:

- full-time HDR and GPG numbers increased by 7% and decreased by 1.2% respectively
- part-time HDR and GPG numbers decreased by 0.62% and decreased by 2.3% respectively

Attendance mode

The majority of postgraduates, 68% in 2006 and 2007, and 69% in 2008 were enrolled via internal mode. The majority of postgraduates enrolled via external mode, both in 2006 and 2007, were enrolled through the Clayton campus. The campus with the highest proportion of its students enrolled via external mode each year was Gippsland.

Between 2006 and 2007:

- the number of HDR postgraduates enrolled via internal and external mode increased by 2.7% and 3.4% respectively
- the number of GPG postgraduates enrolled via internal increased by 1.4% while GPG enrolled via external mode decreased by 3.8%

Between 2007 and 2008:

- the number of HDR postgraduates enrolled via internal and external mode increased by 5.9% and decreased by 10.9% respectively
- the number of GPG postgraduates enrolled via internal and external mode decreased by 2% and 0.8% respectively

Indigenous postgraduate numbers

There were 29 Indigenous postgraduate enrolments in 2006, 36 in 2007 and 29 in 2008.

Of the 2007 enrolments, 30 were either at Clayton or Caulfield campus, 64% were female and enrolments were divided evenly between full and part-time. Fifty-three percent were enrolled internally while 39% were enrolled externally.

Of the 2008 enrolments, 25 were either at Clayton or Caulfield campus and 69% were female. Eleven were enrolled full-time and 18 were enrolled part-time. Fifty-five percent were enrolled internally while 38% were enrolled externally.

University-wide student numbers at a glance

In 2008, 55,795 students were enrolled at Monash University of whom 15,741 were postgraduates.

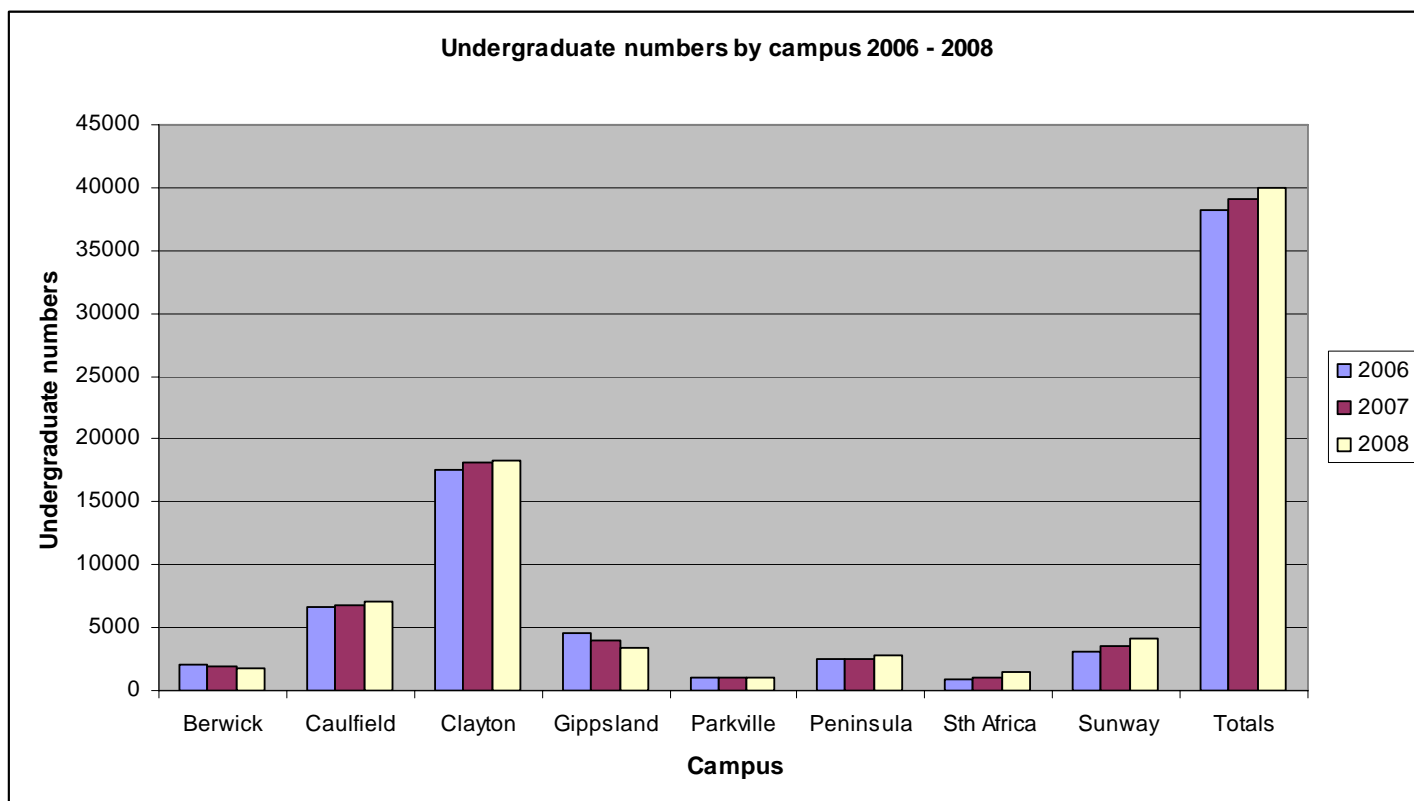
Total undergraduate numbers grew each year from 38,222 in 2006 to 40,054 in 2008.

Total postgraduate numbers peaked in 2007 at 15,817 and declined to 15,741 in 2008.

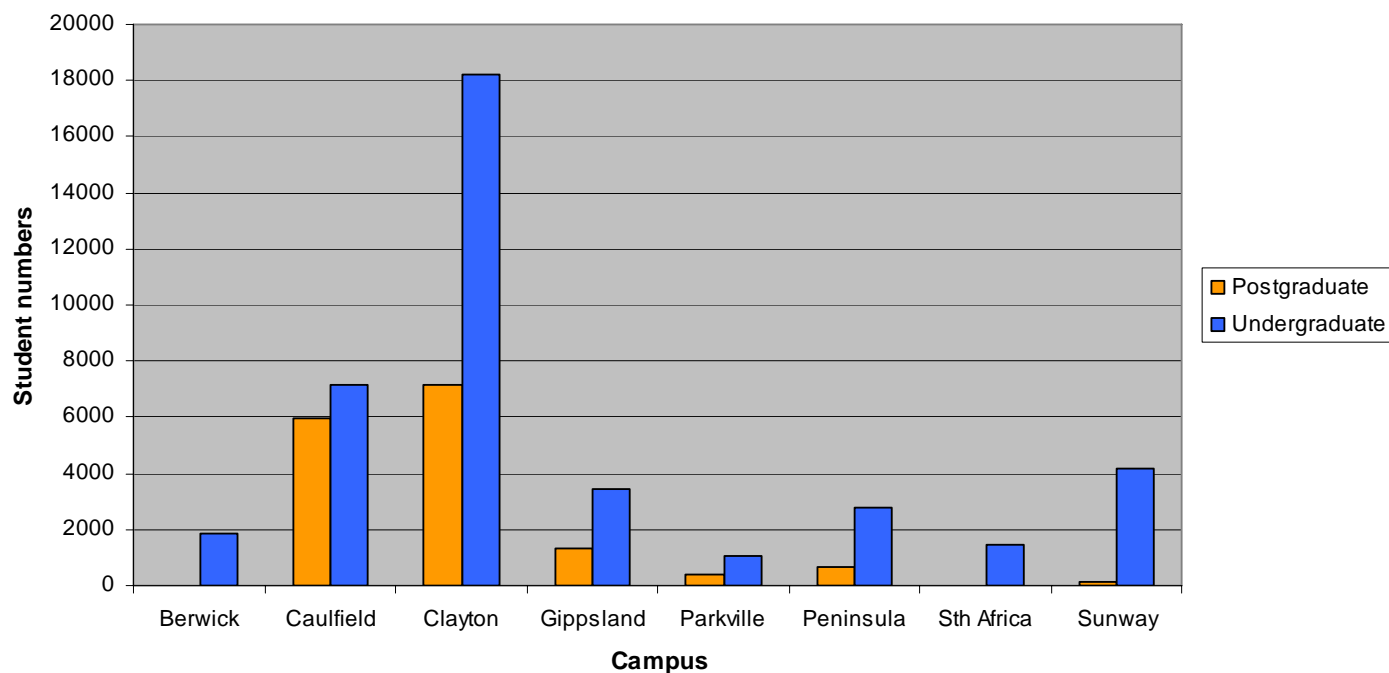

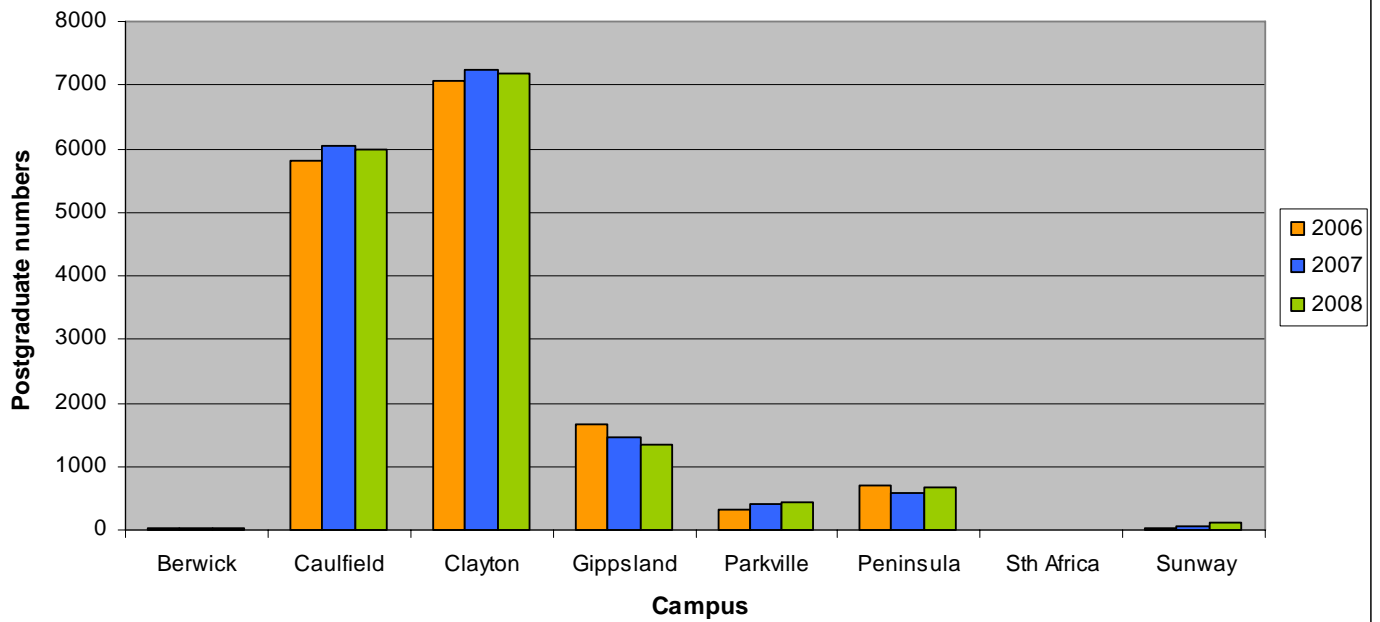
Postgraduate vs undergraduate numbers by campus, 2008

Between 2006 and 2008 postgraduate numbers decreased overall by 1%.

Caulfield and Clayton increased marginally (3% and 2% respectively). Change was more pronounced on the smaller campuses: numbers increased at Parkville and Sunway, but declined at Berwick, Gippsland, Peninsula and South Africa.

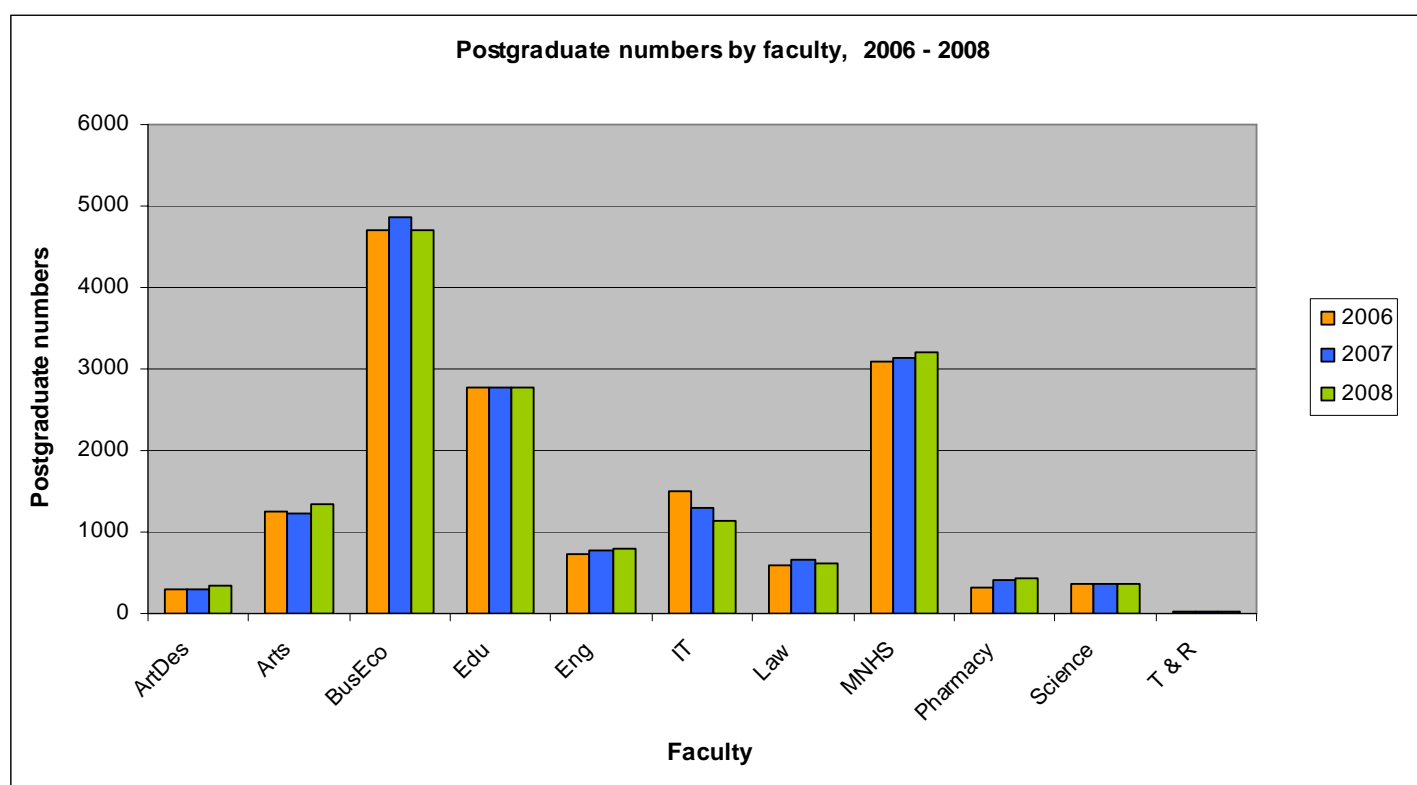

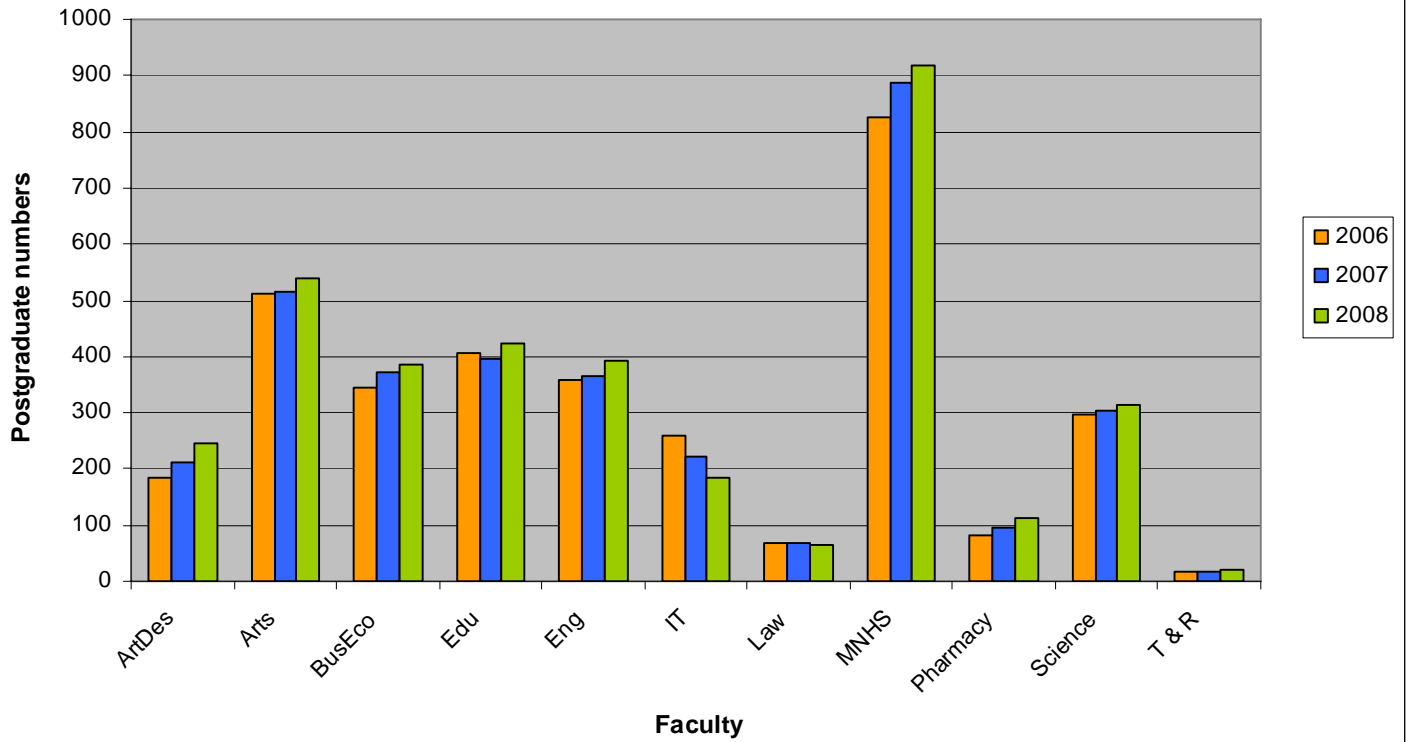

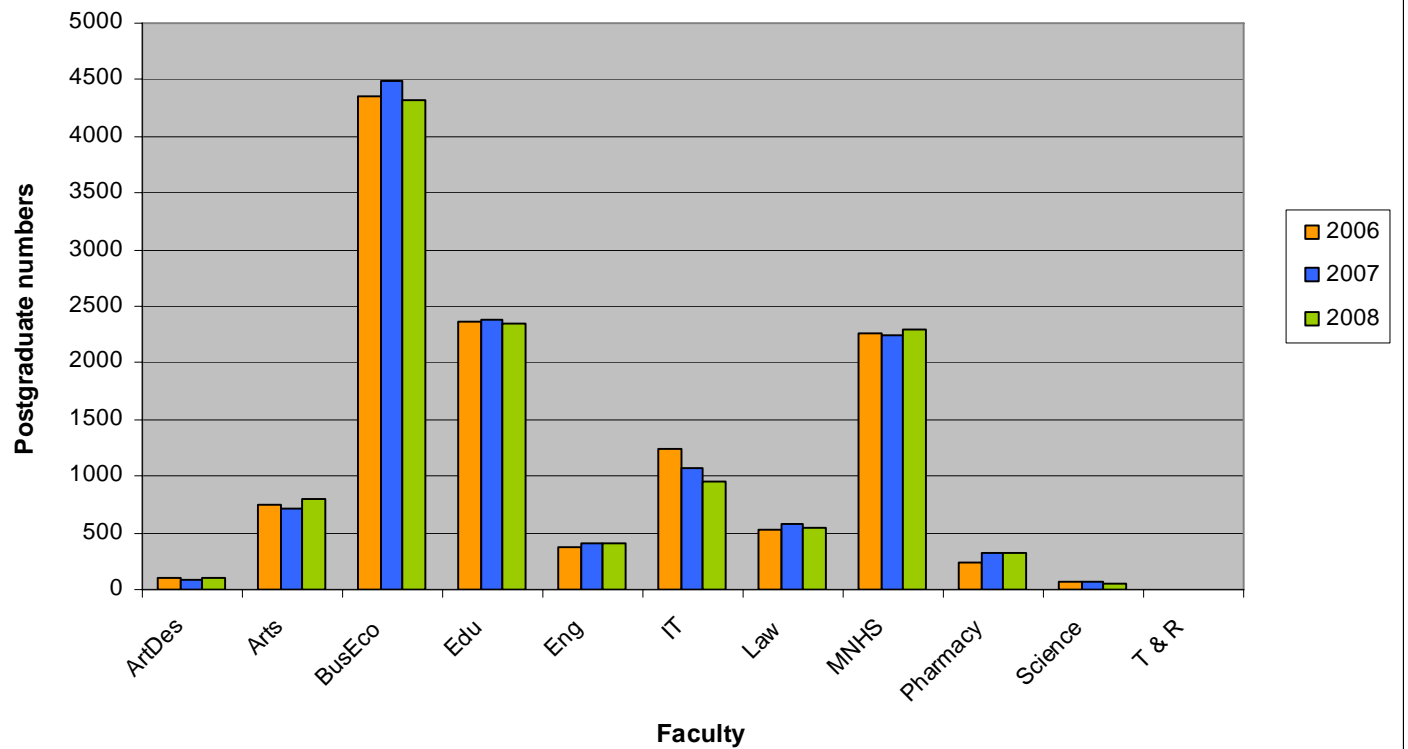

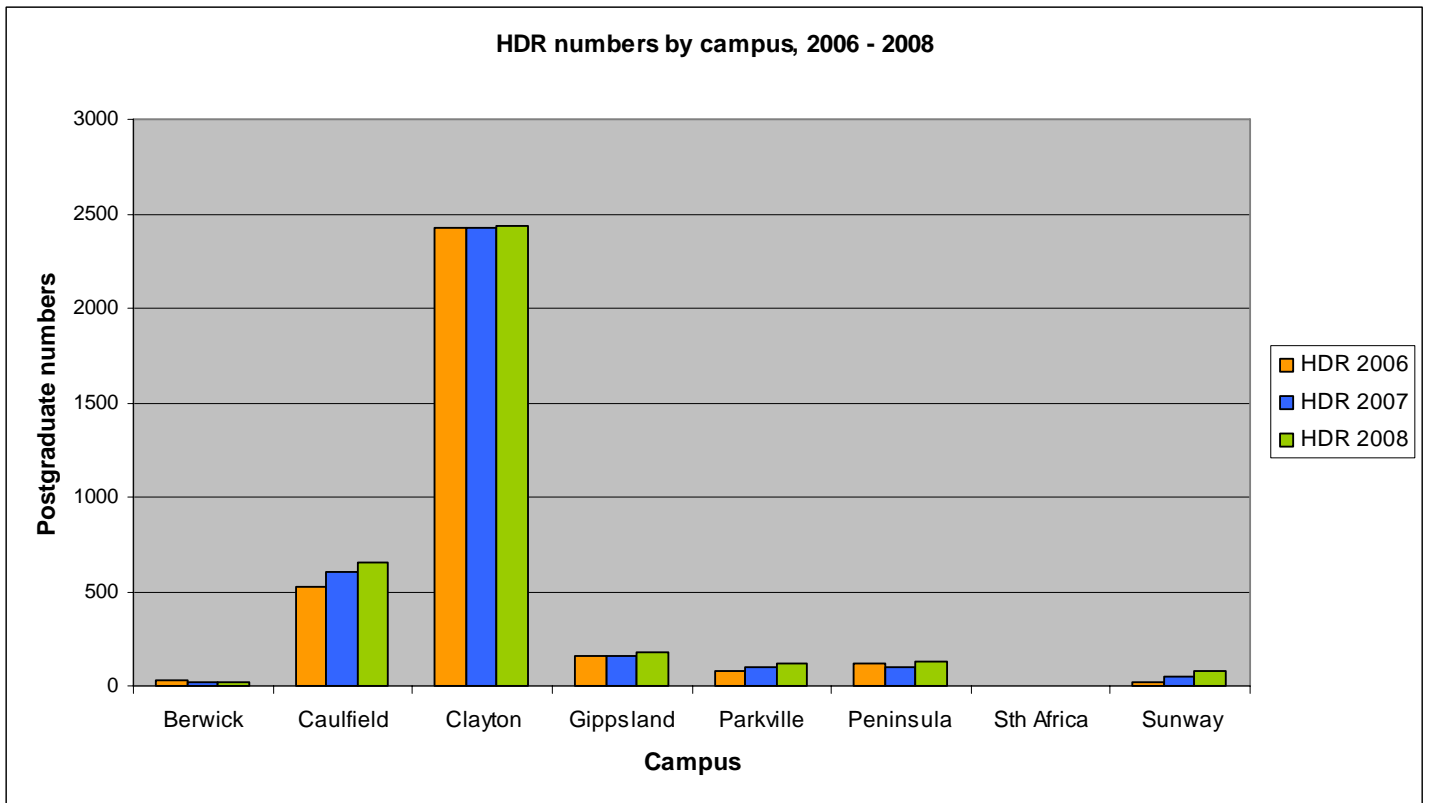

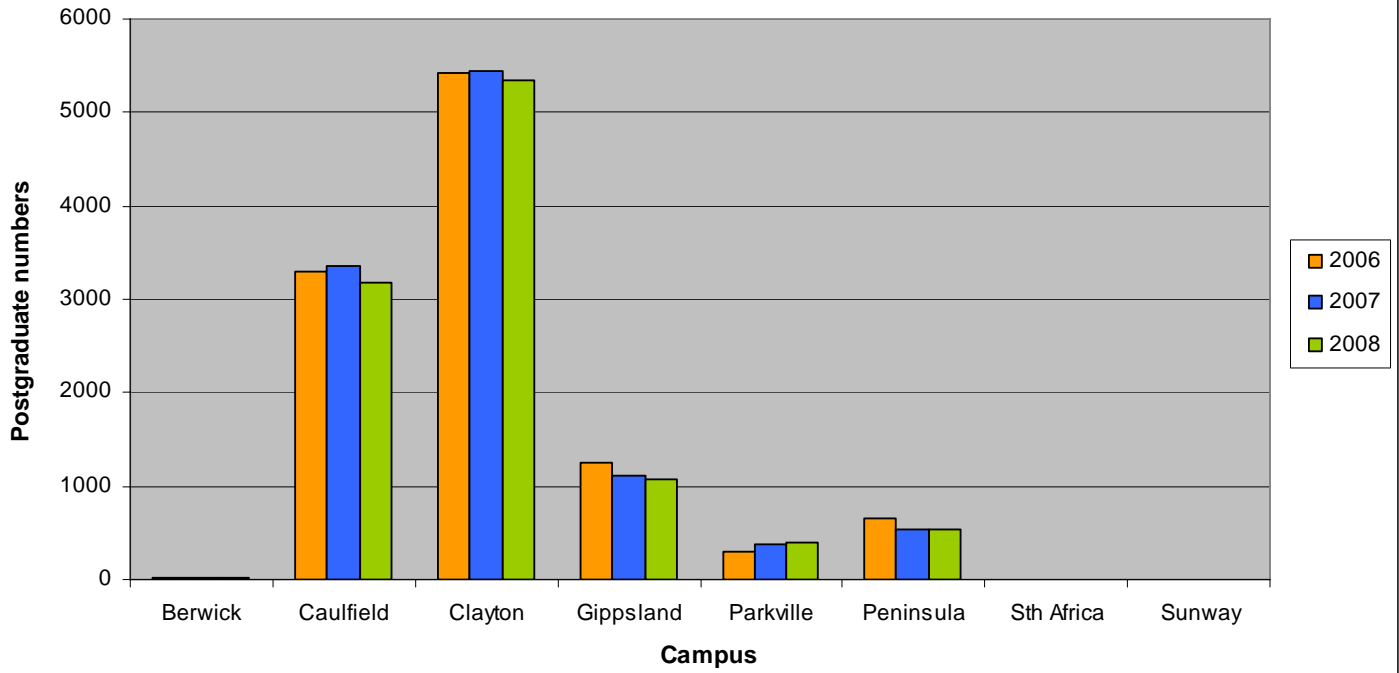

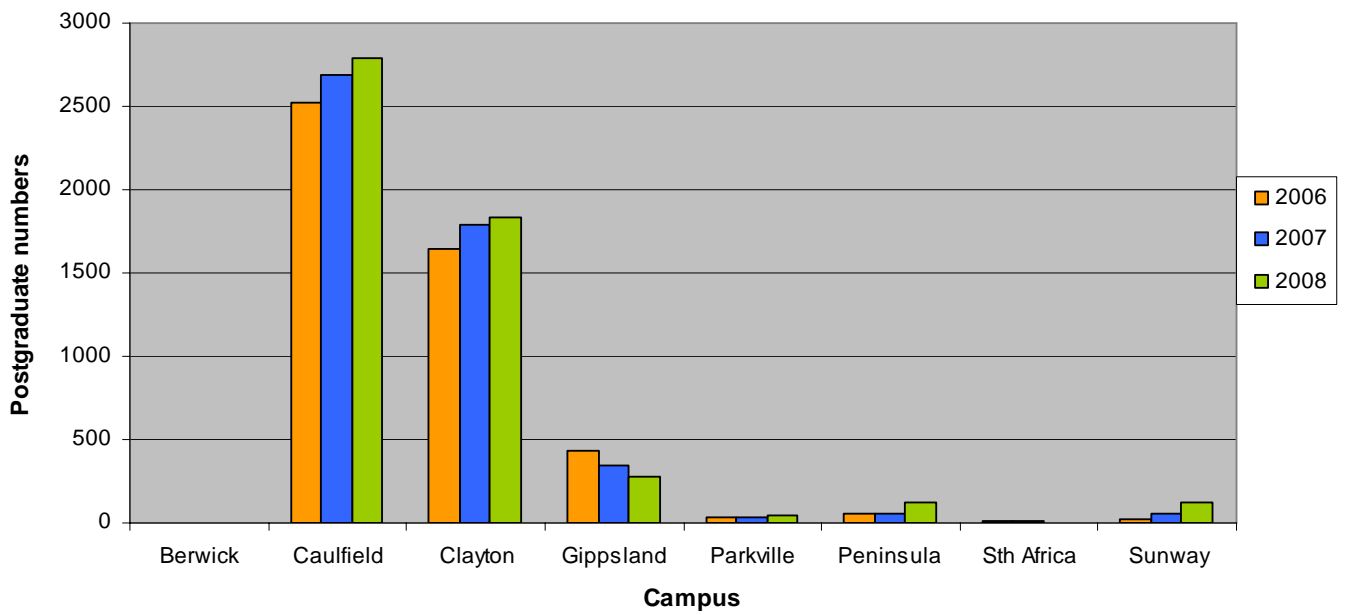

The majority of postgraduates – 68% in 2006 and 2007, and 69% in 2008 – were enrolled via internal mode. Each year, the majority of postgraduates enrolled via external mode were enrolled through the Clayton campus.

The campus with the highest proportion of postgraduates enrolled via external mode was Gippsland.

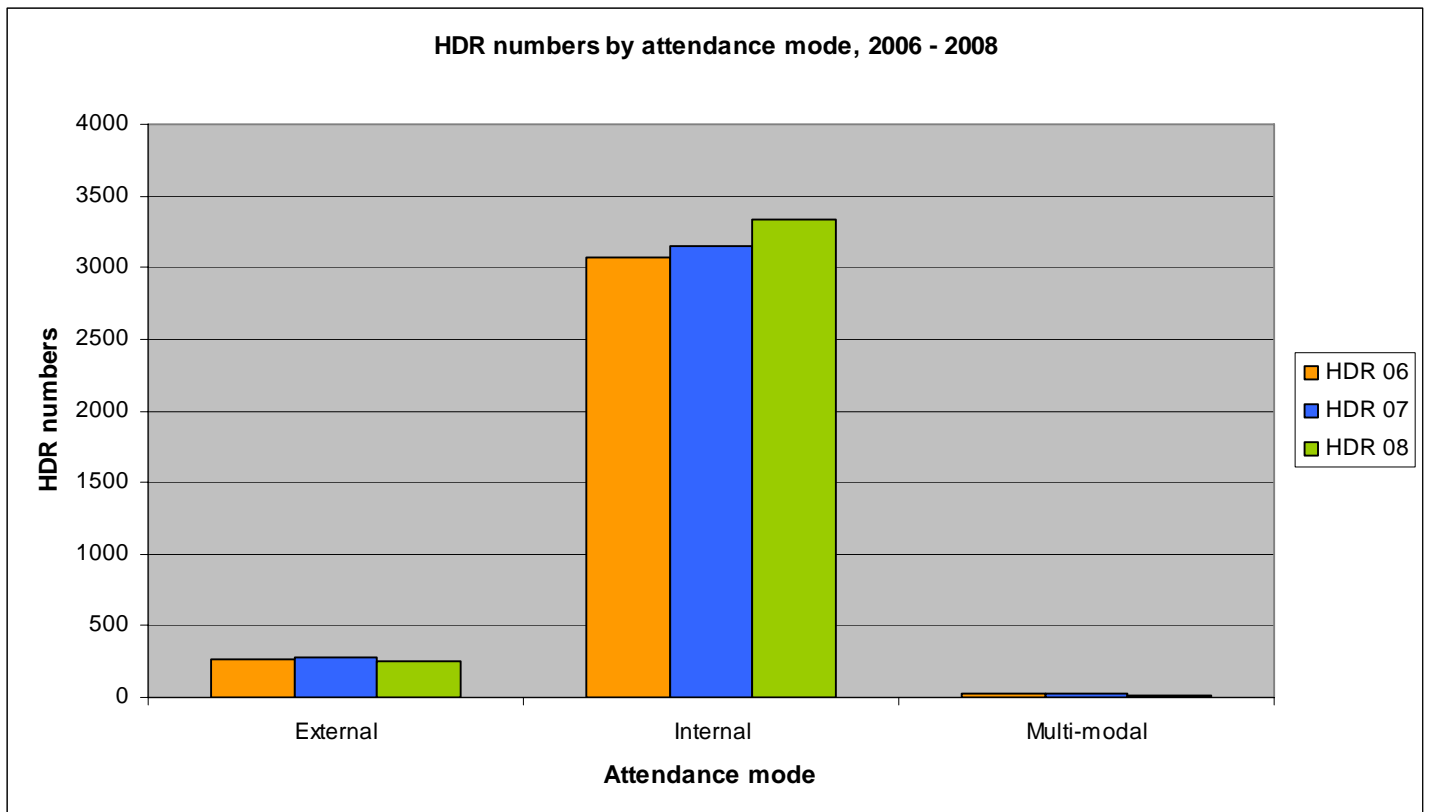

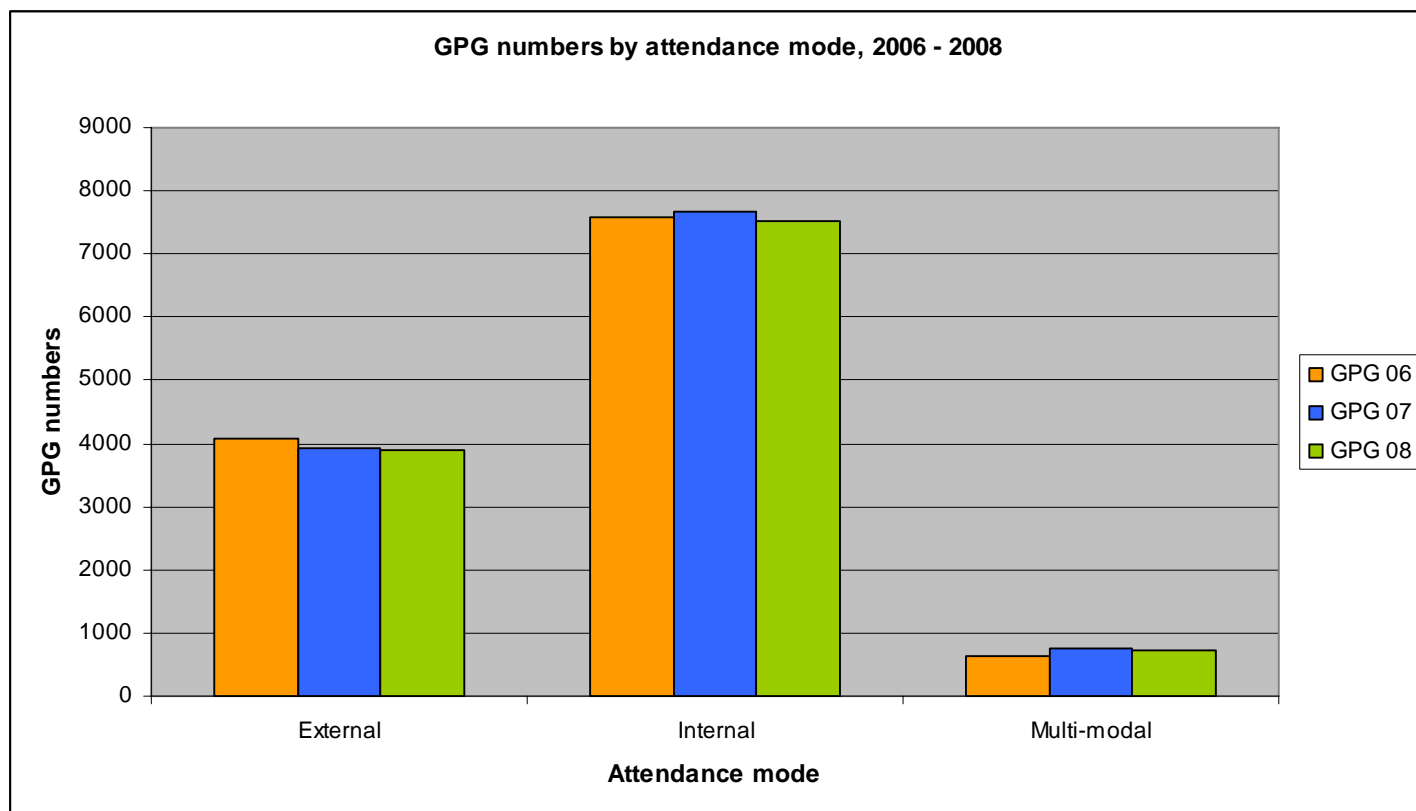

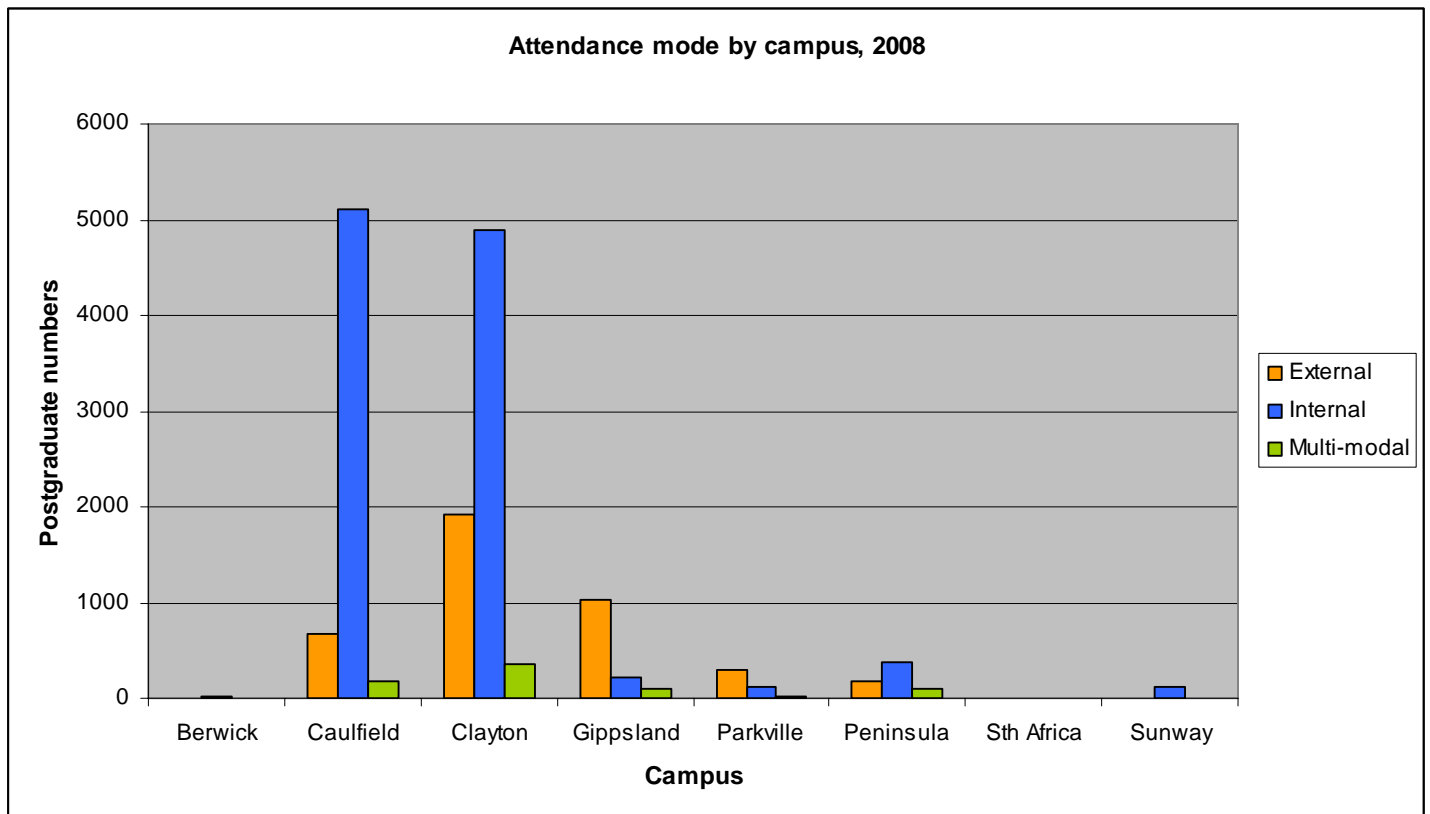
